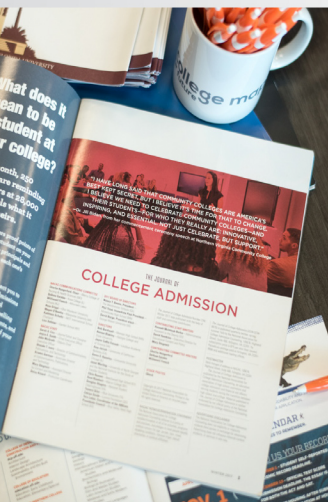

PREP STEPS

DIAGNOSTIC

Our diagnostic test determines whether a student's strength test is the ACT or SAT. The results indicate which test the student will prepare for.

TEST PREP

Our program is a combination of instructor-led classes and independent practice. For best results, we recommend 12 prep sessions prior to each test.

SAT or ACT

On average, our students take the test 4 times during their junior year.

Your prep schedule will be based on the actual tests you're taking.

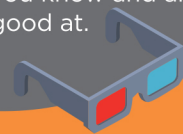
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Career Exploration: What do you want to be?
